
#### **Gutenberg Blocks in PHP**



- Ability to create blocks with PHP
- Reliance on a plugin as a gateway to the WordPress core APIs
- No need to switch to JS/React stack (sort of)
- Has library of readily-made blocks from the ACF developers on WordPress plugin repository



#### **Gutenberg Blocks in React**



- The "core" way to build blocks
- Use WordPress APIs directly
- "More" sustainable in the long run
- Native experience for backend users




#### (Rant about ) Gutenberg Development

- And much more....


